



## Invitation for Expressions of Interest

The Dakchyata: TVET Practical Partnership project, funded by the European Union and managed by the British Council, today launches a call for Expressions of Interest (EOI) from interested Nepali organisations to apply for grants under the Practical Partnership Fund.

The **Practical Partnership Fund** provides grants to eligible organisations to deliver projects which strengthen the relevance, quality and sustainability of Technical Education and Vocational Training in Nepal, through a Public-Private Partnership approach. Funds are available up to a maximum of EUR 200,000 per project for Type1 grant projects and EUR 350,000 per project for Type 2 grant project, activities in our three target sectors: Agriculture, Construction and Tourism.

Eligible Organisations include private enterprises, employer associations, federations, chambers, confederations, TVET service providers, cooperatives, and NGOs. Full eligibility requirements are available on our website.
